

# Pre-Kindergarten 3

## Curriculum



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**PK3** is a very exciting time at St. Andrew's! It is a time where we begin preparing our students for PK4 and Kindergarten. Many concepts are taught through small group learning centers as well as outdoor activities. We build on the interest of the children and develop themes or focus studies that may last for a few weeks at a time. Different areas of the curriculum are connected and integrated into our theme. We focus on four main areas of development, which include social/emotional, physical (both fine motor and gross motor), cognitive, and language. One of the most important things that we work on in PK 3 is how to get a long with one another. Skills that will last a lifetime.

*Frog Street Three's* curriculum is used in our PK3 classes. Three-year-olds are transitioning from parallel play to interactive play, and their language capacity is blossoming. They are becoming much more mobile, and they are learning to show genuine affection and concern for their peers. ### Language Arts:

In the PK3 program we begin to take early reading steps by introducing the letters of the alphabet and their sounds. First we have a print rich environment where the written word can be seen. Reading takes place and new vocabulary introduced in large group reading time as well as during small group time.

Journals: Everyone has a journal where they may choose to draw a picture and tell about their picture, they may simply write letters, numbers or draw shapes. They may also choose to tell a story to be written down in their journals.

Early Math skills are introduced in PK3 and an exposure to how math works in our everyday environment.

Many things that we study in science are about colors, plants, insects, magnets, the solar system, cooking, and scientific tools.
