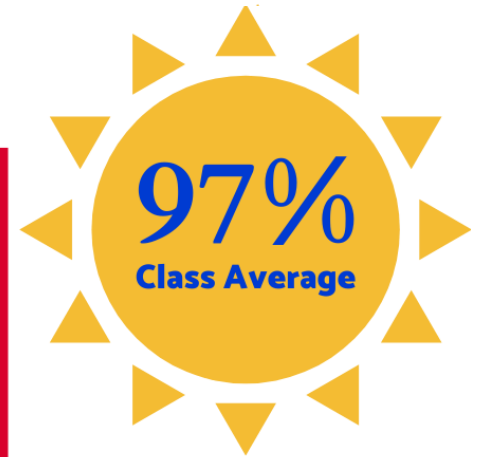
2020-2021 Annual Giving

About the Jason T. Pettigrew Achievement Award

This scholarship was established in loving memory of Jason Turnbow Pettigrew '86, brother of Vanessa Elizabeth Pettigrew Gruver '91, uncle of Jasa '25 and Cadence '29 Gruver, and son of Vernon and Cliffie Pettigrew, Jr.

The family of Jason Turnbow Pettigrew '86 is pleased to establish an endowed financial award in his memory. This award will be given to a rising 8th Grade St. Andrew's student who has attended St. Andrew's since at least the 1st Grade, has an A grade average, and who participates in community service or extracurricular activities. St. Andrew's is honored to offer this financial award in memory of Jason T. Pettigrew '86.

About Jason T. Pettigrew '86

Jason Turnbow Pettigrew '86 attended St. Andrew's for Grades K-6th. He developed good study habits, moral values, and received an excellent education from St. Andrew's.

Jason went to Newman School for 7-12th Grades, where he excelled in academics, football, and threw the discus. He went to the National Junior Olympics in Nebraska, placed 2nd in state, and held the School record for many years. The Outstanding Male Track athlete is permanently endowed and awarded in his name.

Jason then went to Rhodes College in Memphis on a scholarship. There is an endowed scholarship in his name there, and he was awarded Outstanding Alumni of the year in 2005. He played football for Rhodes College, where he received his B.S. in Mathematics. He received his Master's Degree in Architecture from UC Denver. Jason was elected the first student and then young architect position in the Intermountain Institute of Architects, representing six states, and went on to represent a similar position in the Architects Institute of America (AIA) national. Currently, there are two scholarships awarded annually in Jason's name to help young architects afford and pay for their licensing testing and leadership. Jason was also awarded the Lifetime Achievement award by AIA nationally after only practicing for four years.

Jason started mountain climbing while in high school as a member of the Longs Peak society. He summited 49 of the 54 mountains in Colorado that exceed 14,000 feet (known as "14ers"). He had five mountains to go when he fell to this death at 29 years old. His goal was to finish all 54 in Colorado by his birthday the following weekend and to celebrate his 30th birthday on the summit of the last 14er in Colorado. To complete his goal, the last five 14ers have been climbed by friends and his name added to the sign-in sheet atop the mountain posthumously. While in Colorado, Jason led many charity climbs and raised money from sponsors for his preferred charities. His favorite mountain to guide was Pikes Peak. He also spearheaded collections of coats for the homeless in Denver annually and several Thanksgiving Dinners at homeless shelters. He gave back to his community!

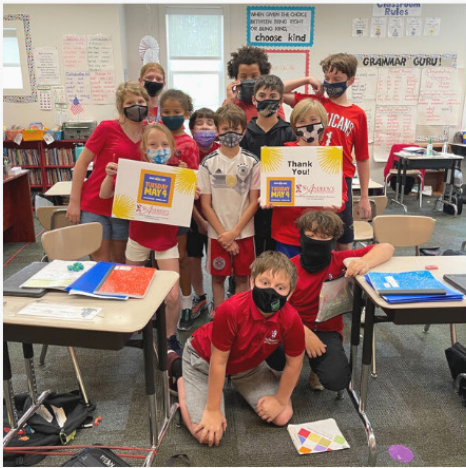
Jason had just completed a four-year course in lay ministry of the Episcopal Church, one month before his death. He was a student of comparative religions, and he was only one step away from becoming a priest in the Episcopal Church. He studied in the Czech Republic and traveled to India and Egypt as well. We found on his desk partially completed applications for Habitat for Humanity, the Peace Corps and Sewanee Seminary. His plans were to finish the 14ers, quit his job, and leave Colorado to pursue the next steps in his life.

It is an honor and a privilege to have been his father, mother and sister.
